



Becoming an IMUNE Licensed Quantum Biofeedback Practitioner

1. Do the study process as below- IMUNE provides free downloads for Home Review Questions, Learning Worksheets. There must be at least 14 hours of classroom study with an IMUNE Trainer for each of practitioner and therapist levels. The teacher/student should ensure that all aspects of the syllabuses are covered.
2. Complete the study record form as you go- this will be needed for proof of study hours.
3. Obtain an Anatomy and Physiology qualification, First Aid/CPR course.
4. Apply for IMUNE Practitioner Level (QBP), submit study record and pay fee- on review that you are ready to do the assessment IMUNE will send information on:
 - a. Accessing the On line exams
 - b. Submitting case studies- 3 are required of 3 client visits each.
 - c. Submit assignments- clinic education handouts on lifestyle/basic nutrition education etc.
 - d. Submit waiver, practice brochure.
5. Continue study using the therapist syllabus, completing the study record as you go.
6. Apply for IMUNE Therapist Level (QBT), submit study record and pay fee- on review that you are ready to do the assessment IMUNE will send information on:
 - a. Accessing the On line exams
 - b. Submitting case studies- 3 are required of 3 client visits each.
 - c. Submit assignments- clinic education handouts on lifestyle/basic nutrition education etc.

Syllabus Summary

First Aid/CPR 8 hours, must have had a certificate, a valid certificate is preferred.

Notional hours are the anticipated study time for an average student.

The nominal breakdown is below- inclusive all aspects. Student hours are recorded by the student. There will be minimum & maximum hours for each element- if less are spent in one area they can be compensated to some extent by e.g. clinical hours.

Purpose- to develop competence in software navigation, operation and facilities appropriate to QBP level.

Assignments/Case Studies

Assignments

Purpose- to develop simple, concise explanatory handouts for energetic and lifestyle elements to support clinical practice.

Study- no specific study materials are suggested. Student to draw on device information available and research lifestyle aspects.

Assessment- by submission to trainer, self review of terminology.

Nominal Study Hours- 10

Case Studies

Purpose-to implement as in a clinical situation learning in order to demonstrate competence in device operation and integration to client health benefit.

Study- the IMUNE Practitioner Learning worksheets can help underpin this process- where the student will apply for an IMUNE Qualification the IMUNE case study worksheets should be used for case studies.

Assessment- grading by trainer before submission for IMUNE validation.

Nominal Study Hours- 50

These can be completed before, during or after accumulation of clinical hours but can not be included in clinical hours.

Clinical Practice Hours

The student must achieve 140 clinical hours with clients and record these. Client files must be available to validate the hours claimed- IMUNE reserves the right to request this. Client sessions should be well documented.

The 140 hours can only be started after completion of level 1- the minimum time is 3 months and the maximum 12 months.

Class Tuition

Class tuition is extremely valuable: 14 classroom teaching hours is an absolute minimum. IMUNE strongly recommends more contact hours. We recognize that this may be difficult logistically and recommend that use is made of web and telephone human contact support. Experience indicates that students will not be clinically competent without the opportunity to have experienced input and confidence building and questions answered by experienced teachers- note that there may be mentors in your area to support this process (contact you local training organization).

IMUNE experience is that health professionals with several years' clinical experience need a minimum of 3 classroom days even when they have done the pre class navigation training, home review questions and reading.
