1.	QBP	QXCI & SCIO are the registered names of the device the USA	
2.	QBP	EPFX & EPFX-usb are the registered name of the devise in the USA	
3.	QBP	The EPFX is a FDA <i>licensed</i> device	
4.	QBP	The EPFX is a FDA <i>registered</i> class 2 medical device	
5.	QBP	SCIO is the name of the software that operates the 3-D Bodyviewer, and many other portions of the program, which can be piggybacked during a EPFX/QXCI session.	
6.	QBP	Terminology within the programming is done by the designer of the program and as such is in medical terms as the device is used by doctors. This does not mean that you can use the medical terms to your client unless your license allows.	
7.	QBP	Clasp 32 is the name of the main software	
8.	QBP	Adipose means fat	
9.	QBP	Allergic Reactance is a component of total reactance and displays in the Individual Reaction panel.	
10.	QBP	Allersode is the energetic pattern of food, inhalant etc at the sensitising potency of 30C.	
11.	QBP	Calibration is the initial process of establishing interface with the client, where the client's optimum reactivity response (time of exposure) is established to a variety of items (approximately 20) ranging from the innocuous to the toxic.	
12.	QBP	Coherence is a measurement of the percentage of how close the return signal is to the original input signal. It generally increases if there is a harmonic reaction of the client, with numbers above 75 indicating a positive reaction. It may be useful for discriminating between remedies.	
13.	QBP	Dark Field is a method of viewing blood for disturbances under a specialised microscope system.	
14.	QBP	ECG stands for Electro Cardiograph (indication of heart activity).	
15.	QBP	EEG stands for Electro Encephalo Graph (indication of brainwave activity).	
16.	QBP	EPR means Electro Physiological Reactivity.	
17.	QBP	A Homeopathic is an energetic remedy prepared from any substance and often diluted so much that there is none of the original material remaining and only an energetic pattern remains.	
18.	QBP	The strength of a homeopathic is referred to as its potency .	
19.	QBP	The higher the potency the deeper the effect of the homeopathic and	

		the more dilute it is.	
20.	QBP	GSR stands for galvanic skin resistance.	
21.	QBP	Body Capacitance is the ratio of charge to potential, being an indicator of the body's energy storing characteristics.	
22.	QBP	Fourier number is a mathematical relationship number of the resulting seven part harmonic dissection. This is a complicated mathematical set of numbers which is presented at various places in the QX but for which no correlative information currently exists.	
23.	QBP	There is such thing as an intrinsically good food .	
24.	QBP	There is only food . The client reaction to it makes it good or otherwise just for that client.	
25.	QBP	Hyper-reactivity is where the client's body energetic is reacting too quickly.	
26.	QBP	Hyper-reactivity may result in a lot of high reactivities being displayed and thus can make it difficult to filter the significant reactivities.	
27.	QBP	Hypo-reactivity is where the client's body energetic is weakly reacting.	
28.	QBP	Hypo-reactivity may result in significant reactive information not being present in the top scores.	
29.	QBP	The software automatically detects hyper/hypo reactivity	
30.	QBP	The software automatically tries to compensate for hyper/hypo reactivity.	
31.	QBP	Impedance is the ability of a medium to conduct current, being the ratio of an induced voltage to injected current in a conductive media and having the two components of resistance and reactance.	
32.	QBP	Interface Value (Calibration) is an indication of the accuracy of interface with the client.	
33.	QBP	Isode is the energetic pattern of a material	
34.	QBP	Major Resonant Frequency is the predominant frequency of the client's energetic body. It is a calculation from electrical parameters historically used for calculating the resonant frequency of an electrical circuit.	
35.	QBP	In Muscle Disturbance (sarcode) a high number indicates a disturbance but not necessarily intrinsic in the tissue.	
36.	QBP	Muscle Tension shows in certain sarcode tests, the higher number indicating a higher tension or tightness.	
37.	QBP	Nosode is the energetic pattern of diseased tissue or pathogens.	
38.	QBP	Phase Angle is the time delay between a stimulating current and the voltage generated by an alternating current of 50 KHZ in the conductive media, expressed in degrees of phase shift. One complete cycle of current represents 360 degrees, so a phase shift of 6 degrees represents a shift of $\frac{6}{360}^{\text{ths}}$ of a cycle or 1.67%.	
39.	QBP	Phase Contrast is a method of viewing blood for disturbances under a specialised microscope system.	
40.	QBP	Electron Pressure is an indication of the pressure exerted by the	

		electron content of the client's body electric.	
41.	QBP	Proton Pressure is an indication of the pressure exerted by the proton content of the client's body electric.	
42.	QBP	Purple Colour Band in the test screen represents items that the client has reactivity to of more than two standard deviations from the mean reactivity.	
43.	QBP	Reactance is the component of impedance related to the storage of energy in a conductive media.	
44.	QBP	Reactance Speed Index is the number of times that the QX has had to adjust the testing speed downwards in order to get an optimum reaction from the client's body electric.	
45.	QBP	Reactivity is the client energetic response resulting in a score relating to the significance of a client's unconscious response to an item after an exposure of between $\frac{1}{80}^{\text{th}}$ and $\frac{1}{100}^{\text{th}}$ of a second.	
46.	QBP	Rectified is an indication that an energetic disturbance has been repaired according to the way the QX measures.	
47.	QBP	The Red Colour Band in the test screen represents items that the client has a high reactivity to of three or more standard deviations from the mean reactivity.	
48.	QBP	Resistance is the component of impedance related to the dissipation of energy in a conductive media.	
49.	QBP	Conductance is the reciprocal of resistance and indicates how easily energy flows.	
50.	QBP	Resonance is the patient reactivity to an item after 1 second exposure and is generally indicative of ongoing significance of an item.	
51.	QBP	Resonance will indicate whether an item is beneficial or undesirable for a client	
52.	QBP	Sarcode is the energetic pattern of healthy tissue.	
53.	QBP	Sarcode Resonance indicates how much resonance there is to a healthy energetic pattern.	
54.	QBP	Selye Stress Scale is a rating that indicates where the client body electric is in terms of alarm, adaptation and exhaustion.	
55.	QBP	SOC means Suppression and obstruction to cure, as calculated in the demographics panel.	
56.	QBP	Stabilised Value is where the value is held from the original test and does not change, despite changes in the client in the body electric.	
57.	QBP	All items in the main test matrix are stabilised items: they do not change on leaving and re-entering the test screen.	
58.	QBP	Items in individual screens may not be stabilised and may be floating items. Their value may change when screens are re-entered.	
59.	QBP	Test Matrix Items are energetic patterns of substances, prepared as a homeopathic prior to measurement of their energetic characteristics in an electrical way.	
60.	QBP	Trivector is the description given to the three dimensional electrical holograph that is used in the QX to characterise the body electric	

		comprising resistance (conductance), static (capacitance, amperage), magnetic (inductance, voltage).	
61.	QBP	The QQS device is a proprietary system that measures the trivector of an item to enable its energetic representation in the EPFX/SCIO/QXCI.	
62.	QBP	Yellow Colour Band in the test matrix represents items that the client has a reactivity of more than one standard deviation from the mean reactivity.	
63.	QBP	Xrroid is the name coined by QX for the reactivity testing method used.	
64.	QBP	QIF stands for Quantum Indeterminancy Field.	
65.	QBP	NFP means Null Field Protection.	
66.	QBP	Schuman wave is the 7.8 Hz protective wave that surrounds the earth.	
67.	QBP	Geopathic stress is electromagnetic disturbance.	
68.	QBP	Virtual is non physical.	
69.	QBP	Subspace is non physical.	
70.	QBP	Radionics is non physical.	
71.	QBP	Scalar wave is the resultant energy when two physical waves meet under circumstances that there is no obvious physical energy manifestation from this and the energy probably transits to a higher dimension.	
72.	QBP	Positive Consciousness Field is a harmonious field.	
73.	QBP	Remote Viewing is the facility to observe places and events from a distance.	
74.	QBP	Superconscious is our main part outside our verbal etc conscious/aware aspect, generally part of our higher self.	
75.	QBP	Conscious is our verbal etc. conscious/aware aspect	
76.	QBP	Unconscious is used interchangeable with superconscious.
