<i>Which items is it possible to treat from the test screen:</i>			
1.	QBP	Any item in the test matrix.	
2.	QBP	Nothing.	
3.	QBP	The treat button is not located in the test screen.	
4.	QBP	The treat button is located at the bottom of the test screen.	
5.	QBP	The treat button is located to the right hand middle of the test screen.	
<i>It is possible to treat for</i>			
6.	QBP	9 seconds	
7.	QBP	30 seconds	
8.	QBP	3 minutes	
9.	QBP	9 minutes	
10.	QBP	The treat button will treat for 3 seconds, 30 seconds, 3 minutes	
11.	QBP	It is possible to change the treatment time from the treat button (to 7 sec) to 3 minutes to 9 minutes.	
<i>The facility to treat an item for 30 seconds is located:</i>			
12.	QBP	From the treat button.	
13.	QBP	In the individual reaction test.	
14.	QBP	Nowhere.	
<i>To do a 3 minute treatment of an item in the test matrix:</i>			
15.	QBP	Hit the treat button 60 times.	
16.	QBP	Autozaps>Zap 3 mins>click the Zap 3 mins button	
<i>Access autozap is in the following drop down menu:</i>

18.	QBP	Information

20.	QBP	Autozap	
<i>It is possible to treat from the test screen:</i>			
21.	QBP	Individual items.	
22.	QBP	No items.	
23.	QBP	Any list of items.	
24.	QBP	The top five items in the search list or colour code filter list.	
25.	QBP	A combination of various items.	
<i>Methods for treating simultaneously several items includes</i>			
26.	QBP	Individual Reaction.	
27.	QBP	Treatments dropdown.	
28.	QBP	Autozap dropdown.	
29.	QBP	Info Grid with Load report facility.	
30.	QBP	Is it possible to construct a specific list of items to treat.	

31.	QBP	Is it possible to treat the top reactive items for a specific topic.	
		<i>When treating lists of items (e.g. autozap,filter/subgroup):</i>	
32.	QBP	The whole list is treated at once.	
33.	QBP	The items are treated in random.	
34.	QBP	The items are treated from the highest score downwards at approximately 1 minute per item.	
		<i>Reflect on the following treatment times</i>	
35.	QBP	Dense physical items may benefit from 3 or 9 minutes.	
36.	QBP	Emotional items are lighter and may need only catalysis.	
37.	QBP	Flower essences are lighter and may need only catalysis.	
		<i>Reflect on the most likely treatment times</i>	
38.	QBP	Pathogens 30 secondss.	
39.	QBP	Flower essences 3 secondss.	
40.	QBP	Organs (Sarcodes) 3 minutess or more	
41.	QBP	Viruses 3 minutes or more	
42.	QBP	Parasites 3 secondss.	
43.	QBP	Bacteria 1 second.	
		<i>Reflect on the most likely treatment power setting and application locality for the head harness</i>	
44.	QBP	Acute pain: localized and Max.	
45.	QBP	Pathogens: local if possible and double on QXCI/40 on SCIO.	
46.	QBP	Flower essences: local and max.	
47.	QBP	Organs (Sarcodes): local and normal/double.	
48.	QBP	Viruses: head and normal/double.	
49.	QBP	Parasites: local if possible and double.	
50.	QBP	Bacteria: head and normal/double.	
51.	QBP	Will client vitality, age, youth influence your choice.	
		<i>After zapping an item what facility can best be used to see if there has been some effect:</i>	
52.	QBP	Rerun the test.	
53.	QBP	Rectified value.	
54.	QBP	Allergic reactance.	
55.	QBP	Resonance value.	
		<i>Zapping</i>	
56.	QBP	Zap derives from Hulda Clarke where the resonant frequency of an item is given to resonate with an item cell wall and disrupt its structure by resonant effect.	
57.	QBP	In QX Zapping <u>only</u> the homeopathic of the item is being given.	
58.	QBP	In general the homeopathic of the item is being given except for pathogens where the resonant frequency of the pathogen is being given.	
		<i>Customised Lists</i>	
59.	QBP	It is not possible to construct your own filtered list using the search facility and to zap the top 5 items in this list.	
60.	QBP	It is possible using the load report items to construct a customised list	

		of items to treat as a group for 30 seconds or 3 minutes.	
61.	QBP	The load report item button is located to the right of the Go To number button.	
62.	QBP	The load report item is always visible.	
63.	QBP	The load report item is only visible after a test.	
<i>The following steps are necessary in order to use this facility</i>			
64.	QBP	The info grid must be open.	
65.	QBP	Empty info to start new information via information drop down.	
66.	QBP	Drag and drop the items you wish to treat.	
67.	QBP	Load report.	
68.	QBP	Load report items.	
69.	QBP	The individual reaction button will change to test report	
70.	QBP	Test report will do the equivalent of the individual reaction test	
71.	QBP	There will then be facility to treat for 30 seconds or 3 minutes	
72.	QBP	Zaps is the term used in the test matrix when a therapy is done on any item in the list whether for 3 seconds, 30 seconds, 3 or 9 minutes	
73.	QBP	Zaps under the Auto Zap dropdown are a grouping of therapies which are preprogrammed to help with clients needing these therapies	
74.	QBP	All Auto Zaps can only be used one time and then they gray out	
75.	QBP	Auto Zaps are often used as a pre-therapy set up to start the session to do many things at one time.	
76.	QBP	Auto Zap has a filter which allows 6 lines of therapy to be done in any chosen area, if a subcategory or search item is placed in and then the Zap Filter is done then the highest items in that category will be done automatically	
77.	QBP	Auto Zap filter does not show in the Auto Focus Zap drop down until a search item or subcategory is first chosen.	
78.	QBP	If you finish the test and then open the Auto Focus Zap the Auto Zap from Filter 5 min will be visible	
79.	QBP	If risk profile has been used "x's" may occur beside items in the auto zap list to indicate possible treatment aspects
