General			
1.	QBP	The system will only work with human beings.	
2.	QBP	There is no facility for working with animals.	
3.	QBP	The minimum age for working with a human is 3 years.	
4.	QBP	There is a facility for top class athlete selection.	
5.	QBP	It is possible to work with places and buildings	
Athletes			
6.	QBP	In demographics there is the facility to advise the system that the client is a top class athlete.	
7.	QBP	This facility is for use with any fit client.	
8.	QBP	This facility could be used for every client.	
9.	QBP	This facility should be used for professional/serious sportspersons only.	
10.	QBP	This facility will provide access to special sports functions not otherwise accessible.	
11.	QBP	This selection will enable a fully accurate health test.	
12.	QBP	This selection will focus on those items that are athletic performance related.	
Plants			
13.	QBP	It is possible to test plants using the system.	
14.	QBP	The system will automatically know if a plant is being tested.	
15.	QBP	It is critical to enter the name and date of birth of the plant.	
16.	QBP	It is sufficient to enter approximate details and today's date may be chosen as the birth date.	
17.	QBP	Access to plant testing is via demographics>animals.	
18.	QBP	The category for plant testing is "others" or other "living things" depending on the date of the program.	
19.	QBP	Plants can be tested subspace.	
20.	QBP	Plants may be tested by placing the head harness under the plants.	
21.	QBP	Trees could be testable using all four attachments.	
Inanimate Objects			
22.	QBP	The system will not test inanimate objects.	
23.	QBP	There is facility to select inanimate object for testing.	
24.	QBP	The inanimate object facility enables subspace testing of a house.	
Animals			
25.	QBP	Animals must be shaven for good skin contact with the harness.	
26.	QBP	There will be reduced interaction if the harness is connected over hair/fur.	

27.	QBP	It may improve harness connections if a conductive gel or saline solution is used.	
28.	QBP	Animals are energetic cleaner/potentially more sensitive than humans.	
29.	QBP	For testing purposes subspace may be a sensible option for large/dangerous animals	
30.	QBP	There are special head harness and limb facilities for horse testing.	
31.	QBP	If an accessory pad is connected to the black socket on the device then a pad can be used for animal testing.	
32.	QBP	If an accessory pad is connected into the red socket on the device an accessory pad can be used for therapy.	
33.	QBP	An accessory pad is a comfortable option for providing an animal or baby with therapy.	
34.	QBP	Animals should be restrained on the accessory pad.	
35.	QBP	It may be useful for e.g. larger dogs if the pad is within a cage.	
36.	QBP	Animals may get up, walk away and return during therapy on an accessory pad.	
37.	QBP	If an accessory pad is used this is purely psychological.	
38.	QBP	If an accessory pad is used therapy is purely subspace.	
39.	QBP	If an accessory pad is used on a hairy animal the magnetic component only is transmitted.	
40.	QBP	If an accessory pad is used but is not in contact with the animal skin the electrical pattern only is transmitted.	
41.	QBP	It is very important to enter the accurate animal's name and date of birth.	
42.	QBP	Entering the animal's name, choosing a date of birth and specifying animal on demographics is enough for animal testing.	
43.	QBP	Entering an animal's name and approximate date of birth will access all the animal facilities.	
44.	QBP	The type of animal is automatically selected from the animal's name in demographics without manually choosing one type of species.	
45.	QBP	There is a listing of various animals accessible from demographics.	
46.	QBP	Animal treatment without the harness and using an accessory pad may be much easier and nearly as effective as the harness.	
47.	QBP	When working with an animal in subspace the animal name is crucial.	
48.	QBP	When working with an animal in subspace the animal date of birth is very important.	
49.	QBP	When working with an animal in subspace an approximate date of birth is adequate, if a date is not suspected the first date of therapy can be substituted.	
50.	QBP	When working in subspace intention is an important aspect.	
51.	QBP	When working in subspace only the device and subject are interconnected.	
52.	QBP	When working in subspace the intent of the practitioner may be an
