6.	QBP	Running down the computer battery and recharging.	
7.	QBP	Checking the hard disk space.	
8.	QBP	Updating the anti virus program if the computer is regularly used for internet.

24.	QBP	Can a short hibernation time setting interfere with the operation of the clasp program?	
25.	QBP	Have you now set screen saver to 120 minutes or more?	
<i>Power saver settings</i>			

26.	QBP	Power saver settings is accessed via Start>Settings>Control Panel>Display>Screen Saver>Power	
27.	QBP	Are all settings for mains power plugged in set to never?	
28.	QBP	Are battery settings set to 2 hours or more?	
<i>If the above are not set to long times then:</i>			
29.	QBP	There will be no problem.	
30.	QBP	The program will crash.	
31.	QBP	The program may stop sending signals.	
<i>The Windows Clock:</i>			
32.	QBP	The clock can be accessed by clicking the time that displays, usually on the bottom right of the computer.	
33.	QBP	The setting of the Windows clock is not important.	
34.	QBP	The Windows clock correct settings are important for Biorhythms.	
35.	QBP	The Windows clock correct settings are important for Correct test scores.	
<i>Screen resolution:</i>			
36.	QBP	QX/Ecllosion design on a screen size of 1100x900	
37.	QBP	This means that to see all the screen the best resolution is above 1100x900	
38.	QBP	Access the resolution by Start>Settings>Control Panel>Display>Setting lists the settings that your computer offers:	
<i>The optimum size resolution for 2005 versions is:</i>			
39.	QBP	800 x 600	
40.	QBP	1024 x 768	
41.	QBP	1280 x 1024	
42.	QBP	1440 x 1050	
<i>The optimum size resolution for 2007 versions is:</i>			
43.	QBP	If you have a wide screen then the optimum resolution is a native resolution closest to/or slightly above 1440 x 900	
44.	QBP	Depending on your widescreen computer model the standard widescreen resolution of 1280x800 may not show all the buttons	
45.	QBP	In some screens there are vertical scroll bars on the right	
<i>If I cannot see the full screen or some buttons appear to be off screen then:</i>			
46.	QBP	The program is faulty	
47.	QBP	The computer is faulty.	
48.	QBP	I have not set or cannot set on my computer the optimum screen resolution or have not used the scroll bars	
<i>If the screen resolution is set too low then:</i>			
49.	QBP	I will not see all the screen.	
50.	QBP	The program won't work.	
<i>If the screen resolution is set too high then:</i>			
51.	QBP	I will not see the whole screen	
52.	QBP	I will (probably) see all the screen.	
53.	QBP	The text may be quite small.	

	<i>Resizing the screen:</i>		
54.	QBP	It is possible to open control panel before/after opening clasp and to alter the display for particular screens.	
	<i>The higher resolution is most important for the following screens:</i>		
55.	QBP	Test screen.	
56.	QBP	Demographics.	
57.	QBP	Calibration.	
58.	QBP	Homeopathic Activation.	
59.	QBP	Homeotoxicology.	
60.	QBP	SCIO Body-viewer	
	<i>Glitches: if I have a problem with my program I should:</i>		
61.	QBP	Panic	
	<i>Proceed through the following steps</i>		
62.	QBP	Close down the program and reopen.	
63.	QBP	Close down the computer and restart.	
64.	QBP	Reload the clasp program.	
65.	QBP	Read the troubleshooting manual to see if it has my problem in it.	
66.	QBP	Note in detail the problem and contact my distributor/broker.
